- (1) Ranger T-shirts (any color)
- (5) under wear
- (5) Socks (White)
- (2 pair) Comfortable shoes or boots (water resistant/proof are best)
- Light jacket
- Pajamas
- Dirty clothes bag
- Flashlight
- Hydration pack (camelbak style)

CLOTHING: (clothing should be nylon or polyester)

- ___ 1 Royal Rangers T-shirt any color
- ___ Camp shoes (to wear when not in the water)
- ___ Socks for casual wear (i.e., white sports socks)
- ___ 2 pairs Pants with zip off legs (should be nylon)
- ___ T-shirts (white shirts will not be white again after this camp) I would suggest an extra long-sleeved T-shirt that is light weight also (no cotton)
- ___ Rain Suit (no ponchos)
- ___ Underclothes (no cotton)
- ___ Swimsuit(s)
- ___ Water boots (from Academy they are in the fishing section)
- ___ Light jacket
- ___ Extra clothing as desired. Shorts will be allowed.

PERSONAL ITEMS:

- ___ Sleeping bag or blanket with pillow
- ___ Sleeping pad, air mattress or cot (optional)
- ___ Personal hygiene kit (soap, shampoo, comb, toothpaste, toothbrush, deodorant, etc.)
- ___ Towels and washcloths
