CLASSES OFFERED

We are proud to offer several choice Continuous Learning Electives (CLE's) included with your EDGE25 registration. The CPR/First Aid course will require an additional \$14 fee with your registration. You will have an option to buy a student book for the Momentum Training Series (MTS) classes for \$12 each. If you would like a student book for any MTS class, please select that option upon registering. Extras will likely not be available at the event.

NATIONAL LEVEL CLE CLASS



Ranger Essentials (National CLE) A one-day fun, interactive-style training event. You will learn how to connect with today's boys, along with recognizing ministry needs and outreach opportunities. You will discover how to give life-changing devotions and how to mentor boys and young men into spiritual leaders.

CPR/First Aid (National CLE) A nationally recognized First Aid/CPR course will give you initial and refresher training to ensure the safety of your outpost. This course will include demonstration and evaluation of skills learned in practical exercise. (Additional \$14 fee) (**Maximum class of 14**)

Cultivating a Spirit-Empower Kids Ministry (National CLE - MTS) Teaching kids about the Holy Spirit can be a real challenge. The good news is that you don't have to have all the answers to help kids build a lifelong foundation of being led by the Holy Spirit. *Cultivating a Spirit-Empowered Kids Ministry* will equip you with practical tools to intentionally make room for the Holy Spirit in your kids ministry. (Additional \$12 fee for optional student book)

Fostering an Environment for Connection (NCLE - MTS) In ministry, effective classroom management is not just about maintaining order— it's about creating an environment where children feel safe, valued, and ready to engage with the message of the gospel. This practical guide is designed to equip leaders with proven techniques to handle disruptions, develop positive relationships, and build a culture of structure, respect, and growth. Action camps play an important role in equipping outpost leaders to confidently offer activities they may otherwise be unfamiliar with.

Intentionally Building Relationships (Network CLE) In the spirit of Exodus 4:2, where God asks Moses, "What is in your hand?", this course invites you to recognize and utilize the unique skills, resources, and passions God has entrusted to you. Join us in this transformative experience to enhance your leadership, deepen your relationships, and leave a lasting legacy in the lives of the next generation. Together, let's build a community where every boy is mentored with purpose and love.

Making Leading Interactive (Network CLE) Are you tired of the same old format for the merits you have been teaching your boys? Join together in this exciting class to discover ways of "getting outside the box" and making the merits interactive for your boys and doing them in new ways!

NRA Grants (Network CLE) The Friends of the NRA Grant program is a great way for your outpost, section, or network to get a shooting program started* or to add to an existing program with free equipment. Get your outpost involved with a new grant.

The "Why" behind Camporama (Network CLE) "Why" should I spend the time and resources of taking my outpost to National Camporama? Hear first-hand testimonies on how Camporama can change a boys life. Review some best practices and helpful tips to ensure this is truly the ultimate adventure for boys.

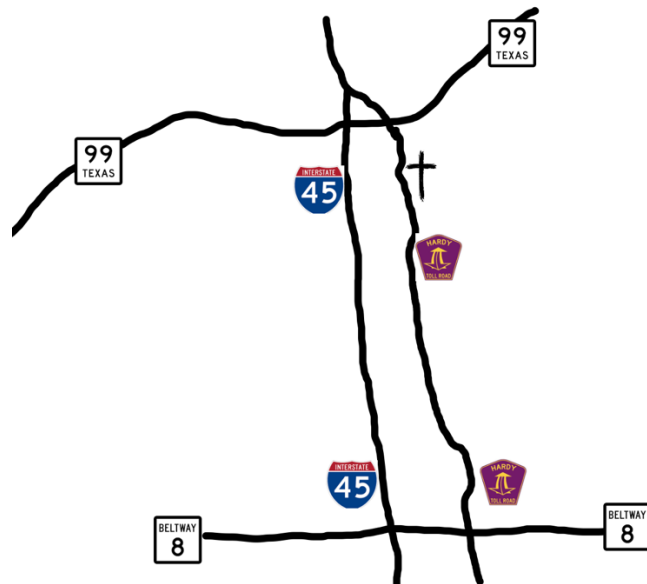
